- Foreign Language Teacher Education and Development
- Challenges in Teaching Online Classes
- Psychology in Teaching and Teachers' Careers
- Technological Pedagogical Knowledge (TPK)
- Multilingualism / Bilingualism and differentiated Instruction in online learning environment
- Online learning strategies

Other themes relevant to language learning and teaching can also be considered.

The conference aims to offer both academic papers as well as insights from practitioners and practical workshops. Proposals are accepted in the following presentation formats:

Paper Presentation: (30 minutes) – This presentation format includes talks which discuss and describe work related to theory, research, or practice (20 min presentation with 10 min for discussion).
